AMENDED OPDER

On November 1, 1982, the Commission issued an Order in the above case granting a purchased gas adjustment to be amplied to all sales of natural gas. In Appendix A of that Order the Commission did not specify the amount of the minimum bill.

On November 23, 1982, Mike Little Gas Company, Inc., ("Mike Little") filed its tariffs as ordered and included a charge for a minimum bill. The tariff included the cost for 1 mcf of gas as allowed in Case No. 7176 (\$2.00) and the purchased gas adjustment allowed in 7176-J for 1 mcf of gas (\$3.39), making the total minimum bill charge \$5.39.

The Commission, after reviewing the record and being advised, is of the opinion that:

1. The minimum bill of \$5.3°, as proposed by Mike Little in the tariff filed on November 23, 1982, is fair, just and reasonable and should be approved.

2. The minimum bill as proposed will have no revenue effect on Mike Little.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the minimum bill as indicated in the above finding no. 1 is fair, just and reasonable and is hereby approved for service rendered on and after the date of this Order.
