## ORDER

On April 23, 1982, General Telephone Company of Kentucky ("General") made a tariff filing with the Commission wherein General proposed to implement the second phase of its expensing of station connections. In the Commission's Orders of May 15, 1981, and September 4, 1981, in this case, General was authorized to file tariffs in 1982, 1983 and 1984 to recover increased costs related to the expensing of station connections. General proposed an effective date of May 15, 1982, for the tariff changes.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that further investigation and possible hearing will be necessary to determine the reasonableness of the tariff application. However, investigation and possible hearing cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED That the tariff application be and it hereby is suspended for a period of 5 months from the proposed effective date of May 15, 1982, The page of the tariff application hereby suspended is:

> General Exchange Tariff Section No. 2 Second Revised Sheet No. 25.8.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That nothing contained in this Order shall prevent the Commission from entering further Orders in this matter, in the event that proceedings in this matter are terminated by final Order or otherwise prior to the termination of the period of suspension.
