ORDER

On April 20, 1982, the Commission entered its Order directing Henderson County Water District ("Henderson County Water") to submit a statement from its supplier, the City of Henderson ("City"), verifying the base rates of 45.32¢ and 50.67¢ per 1,000 galons and the new rate of 54.67¢. The Commission also directed Henderson County Water to reconcile the differences in the income statement and balance sheet submitted with the Application and the income statement and balance sheet in its 1981 Annual Report.

On May 28, 1982, the Commission received a letter from counsel for Henderson County Water stating that there had been a disagreement between the City and Henderson County Water with respect to the rate to be charged and that a rate of 54.67¢ was scheduled for formal approval by the City Commission within the next three or four weeks. The letter further stated that the additional information would be supplied when the rate had been determined.

In response to a letter from the Commission dated July 12, 1982, counsel for Henderson County Water advised that

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the matter was to be presented to the City Commission for approval on July 27, 1982.

No further response has been received from Henderson County Water.

The Commission, having considered the matter and being advised, HEREBY ORDERS that this case be and it hereby is dismissed without prejudice.
