AMENDED ORDER

On December 30, 1981, the Commission issued its Order in Case No. 8281, approving certain adjustments in rates and providing under certain conditions for the further adjustments of rates when the wholesale cost of gas is increased or decreased.

On November 10, 1982, Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc., ("Columbia") notified the Commission that its wholesale cost of gas would be decreased by its supplier, Columbia Gas Transmission Corporation ("Transmission") effective October 1, 1982, and submitted with its notice certain information in compliance with its purchased gas adjustment clause on file with this Commission.

After reviewing the notice filed in this case and being advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that:

(1) On October 26, 1982, the Commission issued an Order in Case No. 8281-J approving Columbia's filing of October 6, 1982, to be effective October 26, 1982.

(2) Subsequent to the issuance of the Order in Case No. 8281-J, Transmission filed revised tariff sheets on October 28, 1982, to be effective October 1, 1982. Columbia's revised filing which tracks Transmission's latest rates as filed on October 28, 1982, results in a reduction to the rates allowed by Commission Order in Case No. 8281-J.

(3) Columbia's notice of November 10, 1982, set out certain revisions in rates which Columbia proposed to place into effect, said rates being designed to pass on the wholesale decrease in price from its supplier in the amount of \$448,439 or 1.8 cents per Mcf.

(4) Columbia's adjustment in rates under the purchased gas adjustment provisions approved by the Commission in its Order in Case No. 8281 dated December 30, 1981, is fair, just and reasonable, in the public interest and should be effective with gas supplied on and after October 26, 1982.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the purchased gas adjustment sought by Columbia be and it hereby is authorized to be effective with gas supplied on and after October 26, 1982.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within 30 days after the date of this Order Columbia shall file with this Commission its revised tariff sheets setting out the rates authorized herein.
