O R D E R

On February 10, 1982, the Commission entered its Order in the above case finding, among other things, that Thacker-Grigsby Telephone Company, Inc. ("Thacker-Grigsby") had failed to file tariffs for recovery of expenses under the first phase of expensing of station connections and that this case should be dismissed without prejudice in the event Thacker-Grigsby failed to file such tariffs within 30 days of the date of the Order. The Commission also found that should the case be dismissed Thacker-Grigsby may file tariffs to recover operating costs caused by the second, third and/or final phases of the expensing of station connections and, further, that Thacker-Grigsby should not be precluded from filing tariffs to recover costs related to the expensing of station connections as part of a general rate proceeding.

The Commission, having considered the matter and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that Thacker-Grigsby has not filed tariffs pursuant to the provisions of the Commission's Order entered February 10, 1982, and that this case should be dismissed without prejudice.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED That this case be and it hereby is
dismissed without prejudice.
