ORDER

On April 15, 1982, the Kentucky Finance and Administration Cabinet (an intervenor in this proceeding) filed a motion for a further hearing in this matter. As grounds for such motion, the Department of Finance alleged that its expert witness in this proceeding has examined the documentation provided by South Central Bell to the Department of Finance and that its witness has ascertained "errors and inaccuracies" in said documents that give the Commission an "incorrect and misleading impression" of the Department of Finance's position in this case.

On April 20, 1982, South Central Bell Telephone Company responded to the Department of Finance's motion by pointing out that the intervenor had failed to identify with the required specificity the alleged "errors and inaccuracies" in the company's documentation. Without a more specific identification of these alleged errors, Bell argues, the company is unable to properly respond to the motion.

The Commission agrees with South Central Bell that the Department of Finance's allegations of error are not set forth in the necessary detail to enable the company to properly respond or enable this Commission to determine if a further hearing is needed to resolve this issue.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Commonwealth of Kentucky, Finance and Administration Cabinet, shall file on or before May 7, 1982, a statement of the specific inaccuracies and errors that it alleges are contained in the documentation previously supplied by South Central Bell Telephone Company.
