<u>O R D E R</u>

On December 30, 1981, South Central Bell Telephone Company filed with the Commission revised and original sheets of its Interstate Tariffs wherein it proposed to waive the Service Order Charge for establishing Customer Calling Services during selected times of special promotions of its services.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that further investigation will be necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff filing and that such investigation cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the proposed tariff filing be and it hereby is suspended from the proposed effective date of February 12, 1982, for a period of five (5) months. Said pages of the proposed tariff filing hereby suspended are:

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that South Central Bell shall furnish the Commission in writing all facts and all available information justifying the aforementioned tariff filing.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering further orders in this matter in the event the proceeding in this case shall be terminated by final order and/or otherwise prior to the termination of the period of suspension.
