ORDER

On January 14, 1982, Ballard Rural Telephone Cooperative Corporation ("Ballard") filed a tariff with the Commission proposing to implement a monthly rate for nonpublished and nonlisted telephone numbers.

On February 25, 1982, the Commission suspended the tariff for further investigation. The Commission subsequently requested certain additional information, which has been tendered.


The Commission, having considered the tariff and all information of record and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that:

1. Nonpublished and nonlisted telephone numbers are optional and available to customers on request and involve recording and directory functions that should be compensated.

2. Ballard has properly notified customers, and no objections or motions have been filed.

3. The additional revenue (\$10,080) derived from nonpublished and nonlisted telephone number rates will not significantly affect Ballard's T.I.E.R. or net operating margin.





IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within 20 days from the date of this order, Ballard shall file revised tariff sheets stating the rates herein approved.
