ORDER

On the 7th day of June, 1982, Union Light, Heat and Power Company filed its Notice with the Commission wherein it proposes to establish a new tariff schedule containing rates, terms and conditions for providing electric private outdoor lighting and floodlighting service utilizing high pressure sodium on and after the 1st day of July, 1982.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that an investigation will be necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the proposed rates and that such investigation cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED That the proposed rates, charges and classifications be and they hereby are suspended and the application of the rates is deferred for a period of 5 months on and after the 1st day of July, 1982.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering further Orders in this matter



in the event the proceedings in this case shall be terminated by final Order and/or otherwise prior to the termination of the 5 month period of suspension.
