O R D E R

On June 24, 1982, the Commission received a letter from Wanda McGuire and Milton McGuire, York, Kentucky, (Appendix A) stating, among other things, that Grayson Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation (Grayson Rural) discontinued service to them on December 7, 1981, that Mr. McGuire was charged with stealing electricity, indicted by the grand jury in January, 1982, brought to trial and acquitted in the Greenup County Circuit Court on March 18, 1982. Mr. and Mrs. McGuire further state that they are still being denied service by Grayson Rural.

On July 6, 1982, the Commission received a letter from Grayson Rural (Appendix B) stating, among other things, that after disconnection, based on the fact that 66% of the electrical energy had been diverted, Grayson Rural calculated that the McGuires are in arrears in the amount of \$6,362.48 and that the restoration of service is being withheld until payment is made for the estimated amount of the service rendered and the cost incurred by Grayson Rural by reason of the fraudulent use.

The Commission, having considered the correspondence and being advised HEREBY ORDERS that this matter be and it hereby is set for hearing on August 5, 1982, at 1:00 p.m., Eastern Daylight Time, in the Commission's offices at Frankfort, Kentucky.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Grayson Rural shall appear at the hearing and present testimony relative to this matter.
