## ORDER

On November 22, 1982, Willamette Industries filed a motion with the Commission requesting that Kentucky Utilities ("K.U.") be compelled to respond to its October 27, 1982, data request D-7, D-8, E-8, F1-4, H-1(b), H-1(c), H-4 and H-5. K.U.'s November 30, 1982, response states that a good faith effort was made to provide adequate responses to all requests.

Based upon the evidence of record and being advised, the Commission hereby finds that:

- 1. K.U.'s response to data request D-7 is insufficient for failure to provide the requested conservation studies.
- 2. K.U.'s response to data request D-8 is insufficient for failure to provide the requested studies which address the relationship between any peak load quantity and energy in K.U.'s service area during 1970-1982. Further, K.U. should provide copies of schedule 14B of FERC Form 12 referred to in its response.
- 3. K.U.'s response to data request E-8 is insufficient for failure to provide either a description of the method used to

project intersystem sales to foreign utilities or the exact location within the original filing of the description.

- 4. K.U.'s response to data requests F-1, 2, 3 and 4 is sufficient based upon the voluminous data requested.
- 5. K.U.'s responses to data requests H-1(b), H-4 and H-5 are insufficient based upon a finding that the requests are neither too broad nor require too many assumptions to permit any meaningful response.
- 6. K.U.'s response to data request H-1(c) was a reference to an exhibit filed in Commission Case No. 8566, Cogeneration Rates. Since Willamette is not an intervenor in Case No. 8566, K.U.'s response is insufficient.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that K.U. be and it hereby is directed to file, within 7 days of the date of this Order, full and complete responses, including a statement of all necessary assumptions, to Willamette's data request D-7, D-8, E-8, H-1(b), H-1(c), H-4 and H-5.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Willamette be and it hereby is granted 10 days from the date of receipt of K.U.'s responses to file supplemental testimony based solely upon the issues within K.U.'s responses.
