ORDER

On August 23, 1982, South Central Bell made a tariff filing with the Commission, wherein it proposed to revise a portion of the Variable Term Payment Plan that pertains to the application of rates and charges.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that further investigation and possible hearing will be necessary to determine the reasonableness of the tariff application. However, investigation and hearing cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the tariff application be and it hereby is suspended for a period of 5 months from the proposed effective date of September 12, 1982. The page of the tariff application hereby suspended is:
