

<u>O R D E R</u>

On November 9, 1982, East Kentucky Power Cooperative, Inc. ("East Kentucky"), by counsel, filed its Motion for Enlargement of Time in Which to Respond to the Attorney General's First and Second Requests for Information. East Kentucky requests at least one additional week in which to respond to each of the Attorney General's Information Requests, and, in support of its Motion, East Kentucky states, among other things that: (1) its personnel is presently involved in the refinancing of pollution control facilities at its Spurlock Station Unit 2 and is responding to requests for information in this case, and (2) the Attorney General's First Information Request was filed more than two weeks prior to the due date and the Second Information Request was filed more than one week prior to the due date; therefore, granting the additional time to respond will not disrupt the schedule in the Commission's Order of Procedure entered October 15, 1982.

The Commission, having considered the Motion and being advised, HEREBY ORDERS that said Motion be and it hereby is sustained.
