ORDER

In Case No. 8620, the Commission determined that a substantial portion of the revenue requirements of South Central Rural Telephone Cooperative Corporation, Inc., ("South Central") has been necessitated by unusually large extended area service ("EAS") complexes within its service area. Accordingly, the Commission has established this proceeding to investigate the feasibility of adjustments in the calling scope of South Central's EAS complexes as a means of reducing the revenue requirements which must otherwise be paid by basic service subscribers.

The Commission, after considering this matter and being advised, HEREBY ORDERS that a conference be held in the Commission's offices in Frankfort, Kentucky, on October 25, 1982, at 1:00 P.M., Eastern Standard Time, to discuss the procedures which must be undertaken to accomplish the above purposes.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that representatives of South Central shall be present at said conference, prepared to discuss the foregoing.
