ORDER

On December 1, 1982, North Shelby Water Company (North Shelby Water), by counsel, filed its Motion stating that because of Thanksgiving mail delays and advanced deadlines North Shelby Water's first notice of the hearing scheduled December 9, 1982 at 9:00 a.m. was published November 29, 1982 and that the second notice will also be published the week of November 29, 1982. The third notice will be published December 6, 1982. 807 KAR 5:011, Section 8(b) requires that the notice shall be published once a week for three consecutive weeks. North Shelby Water requests that the Commission grant a deviation for good cause shown pursuant to 807 KAR 5:011, Section 13.

The Commission, having considered the Motion and being advised is of the opinion and finds that North Shelby Water has substantially complied with the provision of 807 KAR 5:011, Section 8(b) and that a deviation for good cause should be granted.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED That the Motion be and it hereby is sustained.
