O R D E R

On December 8, 1982, the Commission issued its Order in Case No. 8568 approving certain adjustments in rates and providing under certain conditions for the further adjustment of such rates when the wholesale cost of gas is increased or decreased.

On April 11, 1983, Pendleton County Water District, Gas Division, ("Pendleton") notified the Commission that its wholesale cost of gas would be decreased by its supplier, Columbia Gas Transmission Corporation ("Transmission"), effective April 1, 1983, and submitted with its notice certain information in compliance with its purchased gas adjustment clause on file with this Commission.

After reviewing the record in this case and being advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that:

(1) Pendleton's notice of April 11, 1983, set out certain revisions in rates which Pendleton proposed to place into effect, said rates being designed to pass on the wholesale decrease in price from its supplier in the amount of \$69,470 or 25.53 cents per Mcf.

(2) Transmission has filed an application for decreased rates to become effective April 1, 1983, with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission.

(3) Due to the retroactive nature of Transmission's decrease Pendleton should report to the Commission any excess revenues collected during the period from April 1, 1983, to the date the proposed rates are implemented, along with a plan to refund any excess collections to its customers.

(4) Pendleton's adjustment in rates under the purchased gas adjustment provisions approved by the Commission in its Order in Case No. 8568 dated December 8, 1982, is fair, just and reasonable and in the public interest and should be effective with gas supplied on and after April 1, 1983.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the rates in the Appendix to this Order be and they hereby are authorized effective with gas supplied on and after April 1, 1983.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that, for the purpose of the future application of the purchased gas adjustment clause of Pendleton, the base rate for purchased gas shall be:

*Including Transportation Charge of \$.4701

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within 60 days of the date of this Order Pendleton shall report to the Commission any excess revenues collected during the period from April 1, 1983, to the date the proposed rates are implemented, along with a plan to refund any excess collections.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within 30 days of the date of this Order Pendleton shall file with this Commission its revised tariffs setting out the rates authorized herein.
