ORDER

On January 28, 1983 the Commission received a letter from General Telephone Company of Kentucky ("General Telephone") stating that it wishes to withdraw its tariff revisions filed September 29, 1982 which proposed the establishment of a charge for premises visits under certain specified conditions. The letter further states that the withdrawal is requested for the purpose of further consideration by General Telephone of ways to revise the tariffs to accomplish the aims of the premises visit charge in a manner that will better serve all of its customers.

The Commission, having considered the letter and being advised, HEREBY ORDERS That General Telephone be and it hereby is authorized to withdraw its proposed tariff revisions to establish a charge for certain premises visits and this case be and it hereby is dismissed without prejudice.
