SUPPLEMENTAL ORDER

On February 24, 1983, the Commission entered an Interim Order granting the Barnesburg Water Association ("Barnesburg") a certificate of public convenience and necessity for a waterworks improvement project on the condition that Barnesburg construct a water storage tank of 50,000 gallons capacity or less in the Acorn area. This Order also approved the financing for this project. A subsequent Order addressing Barnesburg's proposed rate increase was entered by the Commission on August 18, 1983.

On June 17, 1983, Barnesburg filed construction plans and specifications and requested approval for the construction of a 50,000-gallon water storage tank in the Acorn area. Supplemental information concerning this tank construction was filed on August 5, 1983.

SUMMARY

The Commission, after considering all supplemental information and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that:

- 1. Public convenience and necessity require that the construction proposed in the supplemental information be performed and that a certificate of public convenience and necessity be granted.
- 2. The financing for the supplemental work was approved by the Commission's Interim Order entered February 24, 1983.
- 3. The Commission's Interim Order entered February 24, 1983, should be affirmed in all other respects.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Barnesburg be and it hereby is granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to proceed with the construction as set forth in the supplemental information.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the Commission's Interim Order entered February 24, 1983, be and it hereby is affirmed in all other respects.
