On October 28, 1983, the Attorney General's Consumer Protection Division and the Lexington-Fayette Urban County Government ("Intervenors") filed a Motion for Leave to Correct Testimony. The Motion relates to the testimony of Dr. Caroline Smith concerning Exhibit CMS-9 (Consolidated Capital Structure and Composite Cost of Capital Applicable to Telephone Operations: 12/31/82) and a corrected Exhibit CMS-9 and a corrected response to General Telephone Company of Kentucky's Information Request Item 15 are attached to the Motion. Among other things, the Motion states that the corrections have no impact on the Intervenors' recommended cost of capital or the common equity for General Telephone Company of Kentucky.
