ORDER

On the 1st day of July, 1983, Kentucky Utilities Company filed its Notice with the Commission wherein it proposes to include the addition of a 4,000 lumen high pressure sodium light to its Street Lighting Service Rate Schedule to supersede the existing Street Lighting Service Rate Schedule effective for service rendered on and after the 22nd day of July, 1983.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that a hearing and investigation will be necessary in order to determine the reasonableness of the proposed rates and that such investigation cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED That the proposed rates, charges and classifications be and they hereby are suspended and the application of the rates is deferred for five months on and after the 22nd day of July, 1983.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED That nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from entering further Orders in this matter.
