O R D E R

On September 1, 1983, the Kentucky T.A.S. Committee and the Kentucky Association of Radio Common Carriers ("Movants"), by counsel, filed Motions for Extension of Time (until September 9, 1983 - six weeks subsequent to the filing of the application) to file Requests for Information. The Motions further request that South Central Bell Telephone Company ("South Central Bell") be granted an additional week to respond to the Requests (that is, eight weeks subsequent to the filing of the application).

The Motions state, among other things, that on or about August 12, 1983, counsel for Movants received a copy of South Central Bell's prepared testimony and proposed tariff, and on August 19, 1983, counsel received a copy of South Central Bell's illustrative access charge tariff. The Motions further state that the additional time is required so that the testimony and

tariffs can be adequately reviewed in view of the changes caused by the Computer II decision, the divestiture of the Bell operating companies and the decisions of the Federal Communications Commission concerning access charges, and in view of the fact, according to the understanding of Movants, that South Central Bell will no longer offer Movants its services pursuant to contracts previously negotiated, but instead will require Movants to be provided services under the new access charge tariff which at this point is illustrative.

The Commission, having considered the Motions for Extension of Time and being advised, HEREBY ORDERS that the Motions be and they hereby are sustained.
