O R D E R


On February 23, 1984, MCI Communications Corporation ("MCI") and Western Union Telegraph Company ("Western Union"), by counsel, filed an Entry of Appearance and Motion for Extension of Time (until February 27, 1984) in which to file their direct testimony.

As grounds for the Motion, MCI and Western Union state that, by supplemental Order entered February 16, 1984, the Commission required the parties to address the issue of geographically separate toll tariffs in addition to the previously identified issues. The Motion further states that the Order was not received until February 21, 1984, and that they have not been able to finalize the expected testimony.

The Commission, having considered the Motion and being advised, HEREBY ORDERS that the Motion be and it hereby is sustained.
