O R D E R

Pursuant to 807 KAR 5:056, Section 1(11), the Public Service Commission ("Commission") issued an Order on June 11, 1984, requiring Fleming-Mason Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Fleming-Mason") to notify its customers of a hearing to be held on August 2, 1984. Fleming-Mason was not required to appear at the scheduled hearing unless an appearance was requested by the Attorney General's Division of Consumer Protection or other interested parties, or by the Commission on its own motion. Furthermore, Fleming-Mason filed an affidavit stating its compliance with the provisions of the Fuel Adjustment Clause as prescribed in 807 KAR 5:056. Fleming-Mason also filed its monthly fuel charges for the 6-month period under review.

Following proper notice, no party of record requested Fleming-Mason to appear at the hearing scheduled for August 2, 1984. After reviewing Fleming-Mason's monthly fuel clause filings for the 6-month period under review, the Commission is of the opinion that Fleming-Mason has complied with the provisions of 807 KAR 5:056.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the charges collected by Fleming-Mason through the fuel adjustment clause for the period November 1, 1983, through April 30, 1984, be and they hereby are approved.
