O R D E R

On December 1, 1983, the Commission issued its Order in Case No. 8839 approving certain adjustments in rates and providing under certain conditions for the further adjustment of such rates when the wholesale cost of gas is increased or decreased or a refund is received.

On June 7, 1984, Western Kentucky Gas Company ("Western") notified the Commission that its wholesale cost of gas would be increased by its supplier, Tennessee Gas Pipeline Company ("Tennessee Gas"), effective July 1, 1984, and submitted with its notice certain information in compliance with its purchased gas adjustment clause on file with this Commission.

After reviewing the record in this case and being advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that:

(1) Western's notice of June 7, 1984, set out certain revisions in rates which Western proposed to place into effect, said rates being designed to pass on the wholesale increase in gas cost from its supplier in the amount of \$2,594,751 or 49.87 cents per Mcf.

(2) Tennessee Gas has filed an application for increased rates to become effective July 1, 1984, with the Federal Energy Regulatory Commission.

(3) Western's adjustment in rates under the purchased gas adjustment provisions approved by the Commission in its Order in Case No. 8839, dated December 1, 1983, is fair, just and reasonable and in the public interest and should be effective with gas supplied on and after July 1, 1984. This adjustment is subject to refund because Tennessee Gas' increase is subject to refund.


IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the rates in the Appendix to this Order be and they hereby are authorized effective with gas supplied on and after July 1, 1984; subject to refund.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within 30 days of the date of this Order Western shall file with this Commission its revised tariffs setting out the rates authorized herein.
