O R D E R

On March 14, 1984, Cincinnati Bell Telephone Company ("Cincinnati Bell"), by counsel, filed its Motion to Reschedule Hearing (scheduled April 3, 1984, at 9:30 a.m.).

The Motion states that by Order entered February 7, 1984, the Public Utilities Commission of Ohio consolidated several cases involving extended area service crossing LATA boundaries and a hearing is scheduled April 2, 1984. A Motion in the Ohio case has been made by an interexchange carrier to join all local exchange companies. Counsel for Cincinnati Bell is also responsible for the Ohio case.

On March 16, 1984, Long Distance Telephone Savers, Inc., Coin-Tel, Inc., and Mr. MacDonald Wrightsel, by counsel, filed a Response to the Motion of Cincinnati Bell and a Request for Extension of Time (until April 16, 1984) to file direct testimony.

No objection to the rescheduling by parties in this proceeding has been received by the Commission.


The Commission, having considered the Motion, Response and being advised, HEREBY ORDERS that the Motion be and it hereby is
