- 5. Is applicant requesting to resell any other service besides WATS?
- 6. Has applicant (AmeriCall or Multi-Com Systems, Inc.) previously ever billed any party for completion of an intrastate call? If so, identify the call and the party.
 - 7. What areas in the state does AmeriCall plan to serve?
- 8. In combining both in-coming and out-going lines, what blocking rate does applicant expect?
- 9. Please justify projected number of customers as listed in the application.
 - 10. Provide a list of all possible competitors.
- 11. Provide the location of each of applicant's switching facilities.
- 12. Provide type of switch used, number of lines, and any other available technical information involving applicant's switching facilities.
