## ORDER

On June 15, 1984, Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc., ("Columbia"), by counsel, filed its Motion for Extension of Time (until June 25, 1984) for Responses to Attorney General's First Request for Information.

The Motion states that Columbia received the Attorney General's First Data Request consisting of 40 requests with various subparts on June 4, 1984, that after reviewing the data requests with Columbia's Rate, Finance, Supply and Marketing personnel it was apparent that additional time would be required and that the same personnel required to prepare the responses are also engaged in preparing responses to extensive data requests in a FERC proceeding involving Columbia's principal supplier, Columbia Gas Transmission Corporation, and, in addition, Columbia received on June 11 the Commission's data requests that requires responses to 50 requests that must be filed by June 22, 1984. The Motion also states that counsel for the Attorney General's Office has no objection to this request.

The Commission, having considered the Motion and being advised, HEREBY ORDERS that the Motion be and it hereby is sustained.
