ORDER

On May 9, 1984, Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E") filed its tariff to establish a rider on its G-1, G-6 and G-7 gas rate schedules to provide LG&E with the authority to transport customer-owned gas outside the limitations of LG&E's current Rate T-1 transportation schedule.
