ORDER

On August 15, 1984, Wright Businesses, Inc., ("Wright") filed its application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to provide resale of telecommunications services and facilities within Kentucky.

Wright is a Kentucky Corporation with its principal office located at 611 Broadway, Paducah, Kentucky. It plans to provide the resale of intrastate wide area telecommunications service ("WATS") to residents of Kentucky.

The Commission, having considered the evidence of record and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that:

- (1) Wright Businesses, Inc., should be granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to provide resale of intrastate WATS within Kentucky.
- (2) The rates as filed should be approved, and tariffs containing rates, rules and regulations should be filed within 30

days of the date of this Order and should be done in accordance with Commission regulations.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Wright is granted a certificate of public convenience and necessity to provide the resale of WATS within Kentucky.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Wright's rates are approved and Wright shall file its tariffs containing its rules, regulations and rates in accordance with Commission regulations within 30 days of the date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that in accordance with Administrative Case No. 273, An Inquiry into Inter- and Intra-LATA Intrastate Competition in Toll and Related Services Markets in Kentucky, entered May 25, 1984, Wright shall place in escrow all customer deposits received for service.
