ORDER

On September 13, 1984, a formal conference was held in Administrative Case 282 to review how the Commission's winter disconnect and reconnect regulations were functioning. Following that conference, the Commission decided to amend its disconnect regulation, 807 KAR 5:006. That proposed regulation appeared in the Kentucky Administrative Register dated November 1, 1984.

Having received requests for hearing on the proposed regulation, the Commission held a hearing to consider comments on the proposal on November 28, 1984, in Administrative Case 287. On December 10, 1984, a statement of Affirmative Consideration was filed with the Regulations Compiler and was served on all parties to both Administrative Case 282 and 287. Several changes to the proposed regulation were made based upon comments made at the hearing. The proposed regulation, as amended, became effective January 7,1985.

On December 3, 1984, a copy of the Michigan Plan was filed. It was proposed that the Commission consider adopting this plan for guaranteeing service to customers in Kentucky. The Commission is reviewing the Michigan Plan, but will not address that proposal in these proceedings since it is outside of the scope of Administrative Case 287.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the proceedings in Administrative Case Nos. 282 and 287, be and they hereby are dismissed.
