O R D E R

On September 27, 1983, the Commission issued its Order in Case No. 8799 approving certain adjustments in rates and providing under certain conditions for the further adjustment of such rates when the wholesale cost of gas is increased or decreased or a refund is received.

On September 25, 1985, Mike Little Gas Company, Inc., ("Mike Little") notified the Commission that its wholesale cost of gas would be decreased by its supplier, Kentucky West Virginia Gas Company ("Kentucky West"), effective September 1, 1985, and submitted with its notice certain information in compliance with its purchased gas adjustment clause on file with this Commission.

After reviewing the record in this case and being advised, the Commission is of the opinion and finds that:

(1) Mike Little's notice of September 25, 1985, set out certain revisions in rates which Mike Little proposed to place into effect, said rates being designed to pass on the

wholesale decrease in price from its supplier in the amount of \$41,899 or 60.87 cents per Mcf.

(2) Mike Little's wholesale cost of gas was decreased by Kentucky West effective September 1, 1985.

(3) Mike Little should report to the Commission any excess revenues collected during the period from September 1, 1985, to the date the proposed rates are implemented, along with a plan to refund any excess collections to its customers.

(4) Mike Little's adjustment in rates under the purchased gas adjustment provisions approved by the Commission in its Order in Case No. 8799 dated September 27, 1983, is fair, just and reasonable and in the public interest and should be effective with gas supplied on and after September 1, 1985.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the rates in the Appendix to this Order be and they hereby are authorized effective with gas supplied on and after September 1, 1985, subject to refund.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within 30 days of this Order Mike Little shall report to the Commission any excess revenues collected during the period from September 1, 1985, to the date the proposed rates are implemented, along with a plan to refund any excess collections.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that within 30 days of the date of this Order Mike Little shall file with this Commission its revised tariffs setting out the rates authorized herein.
