FINAL ORDER

On July 2, 1985, the Commission issued an Interim Order in this case authorizing rates for Western Kentucky Gas Company ("Western") effective July 1, 1985. By letter of July 2, 1985, Western complied with the provisions of this Order and stated that its wholesale cost of gas would be reduced by its supplier, as anticipated, rather than increased.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that:

1. The rates previously authorized in this case are fair, just and reasonable and should be approved.
2. The proposed alternate rates, reflecting an increased cost of gas, should be denied.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the rates set out in the Appendix to the Commission's July 2, 1985, Order in this case be and they hereby are authorized effective with gas supplied on and after July 1, 1985.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that Western's proposed alternate rates be and they hereby are denied.
