ORDER GRANTING REHEARING

On June 5, 1985, Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") filed a petition for rehearing of the Commission's Order entered May 17, 1985, on the issue of the disallowance through its fuel adjustment clause ("FAC") of the cost of fuel for generation to substitute for the forced outage at Ghent Unit No. 1. KU alleges that the Commission's Order is not supported by the evidence and misapplies the FAC regulation, 807 KAR 5:056. KU further refers to additional testimony to be submitted in support of its petition for rehearing.

Based on KU's petition for rehearing and being advised, the Commission is of the opinion and hereby finds that KU should be granted the opportunity to submit supplemental testimony in support of its petition.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that KU's petition for rehearing shall be and it hereby is granted.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that any supplemental testimony shall be filed within 10 days of the date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that nothing contained herein shall prevent the Commission from affirming its May 17, 1985, Order in this proceeding.
