O R D E R

On January 25, 1985, the Commission received a Motion, by Counsel, from Grayson Rural Electric Cooperative Corporation ("Grayson") to dismiss this complaint on the grounds that the complainant (Mr. Callihan) has failed to state a claim upon which relief can be granted.
