ORDER

On January 3, 1985, Harrison County Water Association, Inc., ("Harrison County") filed a letter seeking Commission approval of certain changes to construction plans previously approved by Order dated October 9, 1984, in Case No. 9051, as well as construction plans for a project denied in the same Order. The plans for a water main extension in the Jones Lane area were denied because the service pressures based on the construction plans were significantly below the minimum service pressures set out in our regulations and were found to not be in the public interest.

In this filing, Harrison County stated that it revised its construction plans in order to meet these service standards and now seeks approval for the same water main extension for the Jones Lane area. Although Harrison County proposed to amend Case No. 9051 based on the proposed construction plans, the Commission will instead treat the proposed plans as a new filing and set up a new case docket.

The Commission finds that the proposed construction plans relating to the water main extension in the Jones Lane area should be treated separately in a new case. Moreover, to expedite case review, the entire evidence of record of Case No. 9051 should be incorporated by reference into this case.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Harrison County's letter of January 3, 1985, related to the water main extension in the Jones Lane area be treated as an Application for a certificate of public convenience and necessity to construct.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the record in Case No. 9051 be and it hereby is incorporated into this case.
