On January 10, 1985, Columbia Gas of Kentucky, Inc., ("Columbia") filed a tariff with the Commission proposing a Semi-annual Gas Cost Adjustment procedure which would be filed twice a year and would become effective each March 1st and September 1st in order to track the semi-annual purchased gas adjustment filings of Columbia's major supplier, Columbia Gas Transmission Corporation.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that further investigation and possible hearing will be necessary to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff. However, investigation and hearing cannot be completed prior to the effective date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the proposed tariff be and it hereby is suspended for 5 months from the proposed effective date of February 1, 1985. The pages of the proposed tariff hereby suspended are:
