O R D E R

IT IS ORDERED that Union Light, Heat and Power Company shall file an original and 12 copies of the following information with the Commission by June 12, 1985, with a copy to all parties of record. Each copy of the data requested should be placed in a bound volume with each item tabbed. When a number of sheets are required for an item, each sheet should be appropriately indexed, for example, Item 1(a), Sheet 2 of 6. Include with each response the name of the witness who will be responsible for responding to questions relating to the information provided. Careful attention should be given to copied material to insure that it is legible. Where information requested herein has been provided along with the original application, in the format requested herein, reference may be made to the specific location of said information in responding to this information request. When applicable, the information requested herein should be provided for total company operations and jurisdictional operations, separately. If neither the requested information nor a motion for an extension of time is filed by the stated date, the case may be dismissed.

1. With reference to the testimony of R. A. Lonneman, Exhibit No. 5, Net Original Cost Rate Base, state the percentage of construction not completed including electric portion of common plant normally allocated to the Commission's jurisdiction. Also, show how much of this amount is eligible for AFUDC and provide the basis for this eligibility determination.

2. Provide a copy of the 1983 tax return.

3. Provide the workpapers showing the calculation of the \$7,076,207 of the total company \$10,684,586 in liberalized depreciation allocated to the electric department.

4. In comparing Item No. 21, Sheet 1 of 4 in response to the Commission's Order of May 15, 1985, to Exhibit 7 in the current filing, the coincident peak demand for the transmission rate group has decreased significantly from 1981 to 1984. Provide an explanation for the decrease in transmission coincident system peak demand.

5. In comparing Item 21, Sheet 3 of 4 in response to the Commission's Order of May 15, 1985, to Exhibit 7 in the current filing, the weighting for meters has changed considerably from 1981 to 1984. Provide an explanation and workpapers to support the change in the weighting factors for meters.
