ORDER TO SHOW CAUSE

On February 4, 1983, the Commission's Secretary notified W & G Louisville Associates ("W & G") that they were operating a sewer utility subject to the Commission's jurisdiction pursuant to KRS 278.010. (A copy of this letter is attached as an appendix to this Order.) An informal conference was subsequently held on July 13, 1983, between officers of W & G and members of the Commission's staff. As a result of this conference, W & G agreed to file certain written information with the Commission. On November 4, 1983, the Commission's Secretary again reminded W & G that they must file certain information forthwith or a show cause proceeding would be initiated against them by the Commission. No response to the November 4, 1983, letter has been received.

Having considered the information compiled by our staff in this matter and being advised, the Commission hereby finds that W 4 G is operating a sewer utility as defined by KRS 278.010(3)(f). The Commission further finds that W & G has failed to operate this sewer utility in accordance with the Commission's regulations set forth in 807 KAR 5:001, et seq.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that W & G Louisville Associates, Post Office Box 449, Crestwood, Kentucky 40014, shall appear at the Commission's offices in Frankfort, Kentucky, on May 16, 1985, at 9:00 A.M., E.D.T., to show cause, if any it can, why it should not be subjected to the penalties set forth in KRS 278.990 for operating a sewer utility in non-compliance with the relevant statutes and regulations.
