ORDER

On March 29, 1985, Kingston-Terrill Water District ("Kingston-Terrill") filed an application with the Public Service Commission ("Commission") seeking approval of its purchased water adjustment clause and authority to adjust its rates in accordance with that clause.

The Commission, having reviewed the evidence of record and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that:

- (1) The purchased water adjustment clause filed by Kingston-Terrill is in compliance with 807 KAR 5:067, Purchased Water Adjustment Clause, is in the best interest of Kingston-Terrill and the public, and should be approved.
- (2) Kingston-Terrill's supplier, City of Richmond ("City"), increased the wholesale cost of water by approximately \$.34 per 100 cubic feet, effective April 1, 1985.
- (3) The statements of water purchased and sold filed by Kingston-Terrill for the 12-month period ending December 31, 1984,

show that its water loss is approximately 9 percent, which is less than the maximum of 15 percent allowed by the Commission.

- (4) The calculations made by Kingston-Terrill are correct and show that the total allowable increase in purchased water costs is \$62,432 resulting in a purchased water adjustment of \$.38 per 100 cubic feet.
- (5) The financial statements filed by Kingston-Terrill indicate that it cannot absorb an increase of this magnitude in the wholesale cost of water.
- (6) The purchased water adjustment in the amount of \$.38 per 100 cubic feet and the rates in Appendix A are fair, just and reasonable and should be approved.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the purchased water adjustment clause proposed by Kingston-Terrill be and it hereby is approved effective on and after the date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that the purchased water adjustment in the amount of \$.38 per 100 cubic feet and the rates in Appendix A be and they hereby are approved for service rendered on and after the date of this Order.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED that for the purpose of future application of the purchased water adjustment clause of Kingston-Terrill, the base rates for purchased water shall be:
