O R D E R

On May 7, 1985, the Washington-Lewisburg Water District ("District") and the City of Maysville, Kentucky, ("Maysville") filed a joint application for the approval of the transfer of the District to the City.

The City currently owns and operates a water system.

The terms of the transfer call for the City to acquire all of the District's assets and for the City to serve the existing customers of the District.

After a review of the record, the Commission finds that:

1. The City is willing to purchase the District;
2. The City is financially and technically able to operate the system;
3. The public interest will be served by the transfer.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that:

1. The application for the transfer of the District to the City is approved; and

2. The District shall file an Annual Report with the Commission covering the period January 1, 1985, through the date of transfer.
