ORDER

On August 2, 1985, South Central Bell Telephone filed a tariff with the Commission proposing to restore full directory assistance exemption to handicapped, single line business customers and multi-line business accounts who certify that at least 75 percent of their employees are visually or physically handicapped which results in them being unable to use a telephone directory.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that further investigation and possible hearing will be necessary to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff. However, investigation and hearing cannot be completed prior to the effective date.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the proposed tariff be and it hereby is suspended for 5 months from the proposed effective date of September 2, 1985. The pages of the tariff hereby suspended are:
