O R D E R

On December 29, 1984, Pan Bowl Production Company ("Pan Bowl") sold its interest in Public Gas Company ("Public") to a nonaffiliated third party. The Commission subsequently approved the sale and transfer. As the purchased gas contract is now being negotiated by unrelated entities, the issue of related party transactions and, thus, the reasonableness of the rates of Pan Bowl to Public will be considered in the context of general rate cases and purchased gas adjustment filings. Therefore, this case should be dismissed without prejudice.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this case is hereby dismissed without prejudice.
