O R D E R

On January 20, 1986, Cincinnati Bell Telephone Company ("CBT") filed a tariff which would allow the resale and sharing of local exchange service. On February 5, 1986, the tariff was suspended for 5 months to allow for further investigation.

On May 27, 1986, the Commission granted CBT and other parties a rehearing in Administrative Case No. 293.¹ Many of the issues for which rehearing was granted are contained as provisions in CBT's proposed tariff.

The Commission FINDS that a decision on the rehearing has not been reached in Administrative Case No. 293 regarding provisions contained in CBT's proposed tariff.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that CBT's tariff filed January 20, 1986, be rejected as filed and that this case be and it hereby is dismissed without prejudice.
