AMENDED ORDER

The Commission issued its Order in Case No. 9531 on April 16, 1986, in which it granted Louisville Gas and Electric Company ("LG&E") authority to deviate from certain requirements of the Commission's rules and regulations pertaining to the testing of meters. One requirement of the Order was that LG&E must file a new tariff, incorporating the deviation, within 20 days from the date of the Order. The Commission received a letter from LG&E on April 22, 1986, in which it stated that LG&E had not included meter testing rules in its previously filed tariffs and questioned whether such requirement in the Order was an oversight.

The Commission, having considered the evidence of record and being advised, is of the opinion and finds that since LG&E has not previously filed tariffs pertaining to the testing of meters, it would not be appropriate to require the filing of a tariff describing a deviation from the Commission's rules and regulations on meter testing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Order in Case No. 9531, issued on April 16, 1986, be and it hereby is amended to delete

the final paragraph in the Order which required LG&E to file a new tariff.
