ORDER

On May 19, 1986, Multi-Com System, Inc., ("Multi-Com") filed with the Commission a tariff proposing to put into effect a late payment charge of 1 1/2 percent. The payment charge is to be applied to the total amount carried forward and is to be included in the total amount due on the customer's current bill.

The Commission is of the opinion and finds that further investigation and possible hearing will be necessary to determine the reasonableness of the proposed tariff. However, investigation and hearing cannot be completed prior to the proposed effective date.
