ORDER

On September 5, 1986, Concerned Citizens and Businessmen of Central Kentucky, Inc. ("Concerned Citizens"), by its President, Don Wiggins, filed a letter requesting that it be allowed to intervene in the above-styled case. Concerned Citizens also sought permission to introduce the net profit margin formula and to not use an attorney. Concerned Citizens has proposed that it be allowed to intervene without representation by an attorney.

On September 26, 1986, Kentucky Utilities Company ("KU") objected to the granting of the request by Concerned Citizens. KU also objected to the introduction of the net profit margin formula. On September 30, 1986, Concerned Citizens responded to KU's response. Upon consideration of these filings, the Commission FINDS:

- 1. Concerned Citizens, as an incorporated entity, has filed for full intervention but is not represented by an attorney.
- 2. The request by Concerned Citizens for intervention cannot be considered or granted until such time as their request is filed by an attorney qualified to practice before the Commission.

3. The Commission will allow a member of Concerned Citizens to make a statement, on behalf of the organization, in a public meeting which will be held immediately prior to the formal hearing in this matter. In that statement Concerned Citizens may include comments regarding the net profit margin formula.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the motion by Concerned Citizens for intervention is hereby denied.
