ORDER

On January 21, 1987, Green-Taylor Water District ("Green-Taylor") filed a Motion for Dismissal of this case due to the fact that the construction bid tabulations are not available at this time.

Green-Taylor filed its application on April 4, 1986. KRS 278.190(3) requires the Commission to decide a rate case within 10 months from the date of filing. Green-Taylor has been unable to complete its case in sufficient time to allow the Commission to render a final decision within this time period.

The Commission finds that the Motion should be granted because a rate decision cannot be rendered without the required information.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that the Motion be and it hereby is granted and the application is dismissed without prejudice.
