## O R D E R

On August 11, 1986, the Commission issued an Order establishing a show cause proceeding to investigate Pendleton County Water District's ("Pendleton's") additional delinquency with Columbia Gas Transmission ("Columbia Transmission") and Columbia LNG Corporation ("Columbia LNG"). The additional delinquency has been accruing since the negotiations concerning a potential takeover by the Union Light, Heat and Power Company began.

On September 30, 1986, a show cause hearing was held at the offices of the Public Service Commission. Pendleton provided testimony showing that its inability to remain current on the accounts was because of \$30,000 payment on its bond indebtedness.

Due to Pendleton's continued failure to render full payment of gas purchases (excluding interest charges) per Columbia Transmission's and Columbia LNG's status of delinquent account filed December 12, 1986, the Commission is once again concerned about Pendleton's ability to provide continuing service.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that Pendleton shall file monthly status reports, including the total receipts for the month, copies of Columbia Transmission's and Columbia LNG's monthly invoices,

copies of Pendleton's checks for payment of the aforementioned invoices and provide an explanation for any difference between the invoiced amounts and the payments. The report shall began with the month of January 1987 and shall be filed by the 20th day of the following month.
