On January 28, 1987, the Commission entered an Order granting the intervention of the Attorney General of the Commonwealth of Kentucky and Utility Rate Cutters of Kentucky, Inc., in this case. The Commission, on its own Motion, finds that the intervenors should be granted an opportunity to file testimony on any issue set forth in the Commission's Order of December 11, 1986, or in AT&T's response to that Order.
