## ORDER

On January 27, 1987, U.S. Sprint Communications Company ("U.S. Sprint") filed its motion to dismiss or motion for extension of time to the Commission's Order of December 11, 1986.

U.S. Sprint, a facilities-based toll carrier, falls under the criterion in Administrative Case No. 273<sup>1</sup> as nondominant and, therefore, generally subject to an abbreviated form of regulation. The Commission thus finds that U.S. Sprint should be relieved of further response and that this case be dismissed without prejudice.

In light of the dismissal, the Commission finds the alternative motion for extension of time to be moot.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED that this case be and is hereby dismissed without prejudice.
